

Bristol Marriage Licence Records 1633-1837**Thomas Ahmuty and Alice Frideswide Moore****3rd August 1782**

Know all Men by these present that we **Thomas Ahmuty, Gentleman** and **Daniel Leonard, Vintner** both of the parish of Clifton in the county of Gloucester and diocese of Bristol are held and firmly bound unto the Right Reverend Father in God, Lewis by divine permission, Lord Bishop of Bristol in the sum of £1000 pounds of good and lawful money of Great Britain, to be paid to the said Reverend Father or his certain attorney, executors, administrators, successors or assigns: for which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and every of us, jointly and severally, for and in the whole our heirs, executors and administrators and every of them firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, dated the 3rd day of August in the 22nd year of the reign of our sovereign lord George the Third by the grace of God, king of Great Britain, France and Ireland, Defender of the Faith and so forth and in the year of our Lord, 1782

The condition of this obligation is such that if hereafter there shall not appear any lawful let or impediment by reason of any pre-contract entered into before the 25th day of March in the year of our Lord 1754, consanguinity, affinity or any other legal cause whatsoever but that the above bounden **Thomas Ahmuty** and **Alice Frideswide Moore** of the parish of Clifton aforesaid spinister may lawfully solemnize marriage together and in the same afterwards lawfully remain and continue for man and wife according to the laws in that behalf provided. And moreover if there be not at this time any action, suit, plaint, quarrel or demand moving or depending before any judge ecclesiastical or temporal for or concerning any such let or impediment between the said parties. And if it shall not appear that either of them be of any other parish or of any better estate or degree than to the judge at the granting of the Licence is suggested and by the said **Thomas Ahmuty** sworn to. And if the said marriage shall be openly solemnized in the parish church of Clifton aforesaid in the Licence specified between the hours appointed in the constitutions ecclesiastical confirmed and according to the form of the Book of Common Prayer now by law established. And lastly if the above bounden **Thomas Ahmuty** and **Daniel Leonard** do save harmless and keep indemnified the above mentioned Right Reverend Father, his Vicar-General and all other his officers and ministers whatsoever by reason of the premises, then this obligation shall be void or else remain in full force and virtue.
