**Dublin 23 June**

By letters from Boston in New England of a late date we learn that **Robert Auchmuty** esq Consellor at Law died there much lamented for his many good qualities. This gentleman had been an officer of the Crown in these parts for many years, formerly his Majesty's Advocate General and ? Judge of the Admiralty. He was also the first person that formed the scheme and presented it to the Ministry for taking Cape Breton which scheme was printed some years ago in this paper.

**Erected by his widow to the glory of God and in memory of the Rev'd S F Auchmuty who died April 5<sup>th</sup> 1871 aged 59.**

**In loving memory of Louisa Caroline Auchmuty born 1815 died 1897 erected by her children.**

Dear Sir

Having been requested by Mr Charles Auchmuty to give ? in my professional capacity concerning a certain piece of ground at Observatory mentioned to you by him as to its value and capabilities.

Having personally known Mr Gilchrist, the original owner, I am well acquainted with the site referred to. It is my opinion that the property is well worth £600 according to present value of land in the district, at the present rate of progress and the large number of buildings erected and being erected in close proximity, the site is bound to increase considerably in value.

I consider it is quite possible and practical to erect 5 double story houses of the usual type here, including a corner shop which would bring in a rental of at least £30 per month, which rental would, in all probability increase at a very early date.

Should you require any further information concerning the question, I should be pleased to furnish you with same.
