Son of the author and diplomat William Webb Follett Synge 1826-1891, Sir Robert was a distinguished Foreign Office representative responsible for welcoming and making arrangements for foreign royalty at the funeral of Queen Victoria in 1901 and at the delayed Coronation of Edward VII in 1902. In the course of his duties Sir Robert received a number of gifts in appreciation of his services from foreign crowned heads including the present diamond-encrusted snuff box.

Catalogue Note: For an extremely similar diamond-set Wilhelm II presentation snuff box struck with the same unknown maker's mark and numbered with the previous number: 3763, see Sotheby's Geneva, 17 November 1979, lot 121 Hermann Julius Wilm (1812-1907) was born in Hamburg and trained between 1826 and 1830 with his uncle, the Berlin Court jeweller and goldsmith, Heinrich Wilhelm Ludwig Wilm, junior. On his uncle's death in 1836, he became Burger, taking over the firm and becoming Court Jeweller in his turn. Estimate - 6000-8000

#### Biography

## William Webb Follett Synge 1826-1891

born 25 August 1826 died 29 May 1891 nationality English.

A diplomat, poet and author son of Rev Robert Synge and Anne Follett daughter of William Follett. On 27 January 1853 he married **Henrietta** Mary **Wainwright** youngest daughter of Robert Dewar Wainwright a colonel in the U.S army and they had **four** sons and **one** daughter.

Synge entered the foreign office in 1846 becoming secretary to Sir William Gore Ouseley's special mission to Central America in 1856, assistant clerk at the foreign office in 1857, commissioner and consul-general for the Sandwich Islands in 1861 and consul-general and commissary judge in Cuba in 1865. He retired in 1868.

Synge contributed articles to journals such as the Press, Punch, Standard and Saturday Review as well as publishing poems for example Sursum Corda in Punch 1854 and A Patriot Queen in Blackwood's Magazine 1878. His first novel was published in 1875. Further publications include Olivia Raleigh 1875, Tom Singleton, Dragoon and Dramatist 1879 3 vols and Bumble Bee Bogo's Budget: Rhymes for Children 1888. He was a friend of Thackeray, as well as many other American and British writers and artists including JW - James McNeil Whilstler
