In 1845 an assassination attempt was made on the life of Folliott Warren Barton.

Rewards were offered by Colonel Barton of the Waterfoot and notified by way of a poster.

All tenants on Folliott Barton's property added their names in support of their landlord

Reward

A Reward of £500 will be paid to any person who will within Six Months from the date hereof, prosecute to conviction either the person who fired at Folliott W Barton Esq on 31 October last or any person guilty of conspiracy to take his life.

Also a Reward of £300 will be paid for such Private Information as will lead to the conviction of the person who fired said shot or any of the Conspirators.

The above Rewards will be paid by Colonel Barton, The Waterfoot 17 December 1845

Staples - Cookstown

In 1641 the native Irish rose in revolt in an effort to regain their former lands. Because of the dispute between the English King and Parliament, Help for the new settlers was delayed. The little town of Cookstown was abandoned and fell into the hands of the native Irish,

The latter also seized **Lissan House, the home of the Staples family, who were engaged on the manufacture of iron. Forgemen and carpenters were immediately put to work making pikes for the native Irish troops**

It was not until 1643 that troops loyal to the English Crown advance to destroy what was a very valuable asset to the Irish. They destroyed the Iron Mine and Plant, plundered cattle, horses, sheep and pigs, and then proceeded to Cookstown and burnt it to the ground. Even so in 1649 there were enough Scottish Settlers still in the District to established a Presbyterian Congregation at the Oldtown

For 100 years, however, the town lay largely derelict, though markets and fairs continued to be held. An estate map of 1736 showed only 2 inhabited houses in the area of the town. The owner of most of the land around Cookstown at that time was William Stewart, a grandson of the original settler in Ballynenagh. The Stewart family had in the meantime bought out several of the natives' freeholdings and picked up large areas of church land which had been held under lease. In 1666 they had purchased the land lease of Cookstown's founder. Six townlands were enclosed in a domain and in 1671 the first castle at Killymoon was built. By the mid 18th century William Stewart was one of the largest landowners in County Tyrone. In 1734 he planned to build a new Cookstown, south of Cooke's original town.

In 1765 the linen business was started in Wellbrook Beetling Mill, 2 miles west of the town. On 18 June, 1771 Rev John Wesley visited Cookstown and described it on a fair day as "bustling with activity and confusion". His visit marked the beginning of Methodism in Cookstown. During the late 18th century and up to the time of the Irish Famine in the late 1840s Cookstown was a small but bustling town and splendid buildings were built during this period, including a new Killymoon Castle. John Nash also designed other buildings around this time, including Derryloran Parish Church and Lissan Rectory

In 1837 Cookstown had a population of approximately 1500. There were 4 churches, a dispensary, 2 Sunday Schools, a magistrate, an MP, numerous gentry and clergy, one physician, 5 surgeons, a post master, 3 inn keepers and numerous publicans and shop keepers/traders. A market was held every Saturday for linen cloth and provisions and a corn market was held every Tuesday.
